**Major Points Discussed:**

- Mr. Krushinskie reported that as of September 1, 2025, the section has 346 members. This is a decrease of 2 members since our last meeting in Las Vegas in October 2024.
- The section officers discussed the need to appoint an alternate councillor
- Dr. Cirillo and Dr. Shoemaker presented to the section on the RBRVS system and payer reform
- Dr. McNamara provided a summary of the 2025 Council. More than 400 councillors representing ACEP's 53 Chapters, 40 Sections, and component bodies debated and voted on more than 60 resolutions. Three quarters of the resolutions were adopted, at least five were not adopted, and several were referred to the Board of Directors. - The group discussed upcoming webinar topics as well as the potential for an ACEP LAC conference scholarship so additional members can attend in May 2026.
- Moving forward, Dr. LeBas is planning to survey the section and determine how to best integrate section members with ongoing work within the College related to health policy. He encouraged members to reach out and start discussions on the EngagED forum.
